Project Description: The project is in two parts: One part a new testing center and classroom will be newly constructed and the second part will be the relocation of TRIO and Disability Resource Center (DRC) in the Meyer Library. The testing center and classroom will be located on the lower floor to provide a new testing resource for the university. TRIO/DRC will be require the reconfiguration of an existing area located on the main level.

Anyone requesting plans to be shipped must provide shipping account information. The University is unable to incur these charges.
