Project Description: An expansion of parking lot 39 is planned under this project. The new area will be constructed in the adjacent grass area. The base bid will be for an asphalt surfaced lot with an alternate to provide a concrete parking lot. An additional alternate will relocate the parking lot control access gate to a new location further into the parking lot. Work is to be completed prior to the start of the fall semester in August 2017.

Plans & Project Manual Available: Plans & project manual may be picked up on **March 20, 2017**, at the Planning, Design & Construction office, 736 S. National, Springfield, Missouri. Anyone requesting plans to be shipped must provide shipping account information. The University is unable to incur these charges.

Deposit: There is a **\$50.00** refundable deposit check required for this project. Please make checks payable to Missouri State University. Cash will not be accepted.

Parking: A pre-bid parking permit has been provided within the project manual for your use. Depending on the pre-bid itinerary, parking may be made available at the Burgess House or near the construction site. The Burgess House has a very small parking lot. When attending a pre-bid or bid opening, if the lot is full, there are meters across the street on the University campus. The visitor/metered parking area is located to the south of Bear Boulevard on Florence Avenue and the adjacent Bookstore parking lot. Please be aware that vehicles parked outside of the designated areas identified within the pre-bid parking permit or within a metered parking spot will be ticketed. A ticket could also be issued if the parking permit is not displayed as directed. The city of Springfield will issue tickets to cars parked on the neighborhood streets.

Please Note: In the event that the University is closed due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances beyond our control, all scheduled pre-bid meetings and bid openings will be postponed until the same time on the next business day that the University is open.
