



Project: Creation of a Temporary Parking Lot, Mill Street Warehouse

Project Description: This project will add paving to the existing gravel parking lot near the Mill Street Warehouse (corner of Campbell Avenue and Mill Street). It is anticipated the lot will be temporary as the area may be developed in the future for other things. The University is interested in creating a dust free (chip & seal) surface as the base bid and considering an alternate upgrade to asphalt. Parking lot lighting will be provided similar to other University parking lots.

Plans & Project Manual Available: Plans & project manual may be picked up on **May 15, 2018**, at the Planning, Design & Construction office, 736 S. National, Springfield, Missouri. Anyone requesting plans to be shipped must provide shipping account information. The University is unable to incur these charges.

Deposit: There is a **\$25.00** refundable deposit check required for this project. Please make checks payable to Missouri State University. Cash will not be accepted.

Parking: A pre-bid parking permit has been provided within the project manual for your use. Depending on the pre-bid itinerary, parking may be made available at the Burgess House or near the construction site. The Burgess House has a very small parking lot. When attending a pre-bid or bid opening, if the lot is full, there are meters across the street on the University campus. The visitor/metered parking area is located to the south of Bear Boulevard on Florence Avenue and the adjacent Bookstore parking lot. Please be aware that vehicles parked outside of the designated areas identified within the pre-bid parking permit or within a metered parking spot will be ticketed. A ticket could also be issued if the parking permit is not displayed as directed. The city of Springfield will issue tickets to cars parked on the neighborhood streets.

Please Note: In the event that the University is closed due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances beyond our control, all scheduled pre-bid meetings and bid openings will be postponed until the same time on the next business day that the University is open.
