SCA Design Team of the Year Award – Point Criteria Guidelines:

- ❖ SCA Members included in the Design Team
- ❖ Location of Project:
 - The project must be located within a 50-mile radius of downtown Springfield, Missouri.
 - The Design Team members do not have to be located with the 50 mile radius, however the point criteria will be distributed based upon the team’s office locations in proximity to the 50 mile radius designation.
- ❖ Creativity / Uniqueness of Design:
 - Describe how the design goes beyond typical ideas and creates new ideas, forms, methods, interpretations, etc.
 - Include any special characteristics of the project such as:
 - Unique Material Use
 - Sustainable or “Green” Elements / Features
 - Other
- ❖ Functionality of Design:
 - Describe the project type and the design solution.
 - Include any special constraints such as:
 - Site (infrastructure, topography, etc.)
 - Budget
 - Other
- ❖ Overall Quality of the Project Delivery:
 - Describe the project delivery satisfaction between Design Team, Owner, Consultants, & Contractor.
 - Was the Project Budget met (including construction, furnishings, fees, etc.)?
 - Was the Project Schedule met or completed early?
 - Responsiveness of Submittals, RFI, etc.
- ❖ Design and Construction Team Relationship:
 - Describe the relationship of the Design & Construction Teams and the collaboration of their efforts to solve problems and overcome challenges to complete the project.
- ❖ Design Team / Project Design’s Contribution to the Community:
 - Describe how the Design Team / project design generates a positive influence and/or gives back to the Community.

Descriptive information may be attached to the form if additional space is required.

Photographs of the Project are highly recommended (maximum 5 per entry), but not required. If provided, photographs should be submitted electronically with the nomination form.
