BELT SANDER RACING RULES

STOCK CLASS

- Belt Sander is a Standard Product made by an Established Manufacturer/Brand.
- No Modifications or substitutions to mechanical or electrical components.
- Track Guides and Wheelie Bars allowed and encouraged. (See Track & Guide)
- Non-functional Decorations allowed and encouraged.

MODIFIED CLASS

- This is an open category the fastest sander through alterations.
- Belt Sander must propel itself with conventional sanding belt only.
- Modifications and Substitutions allowed to Motor, Drive System, Electricals, etc.
- Track Guides and Wheelie Bars allowed and encouraged. (See Track & Guide.)
- Decorations allowed and encouraged.

TRACK

- Two plywood tracks, 1 foot apart. Sanders race side by side.
- Inside dimension of track is 7 3/4" wide, with 1 7/8" high side walls.
- Race length is 30' long. There is a 20' run-out track after the finish line.
- Race entries must fit into track, and run on track surface.

POWER

- Standard 120 Volts A.C.
- Race entry must plug into standard 3 prong extension cord provided.
- Stock Sander must not draw more than 10 Amps.
- Modified Sander must run on supplied power, typically 20 Amps.

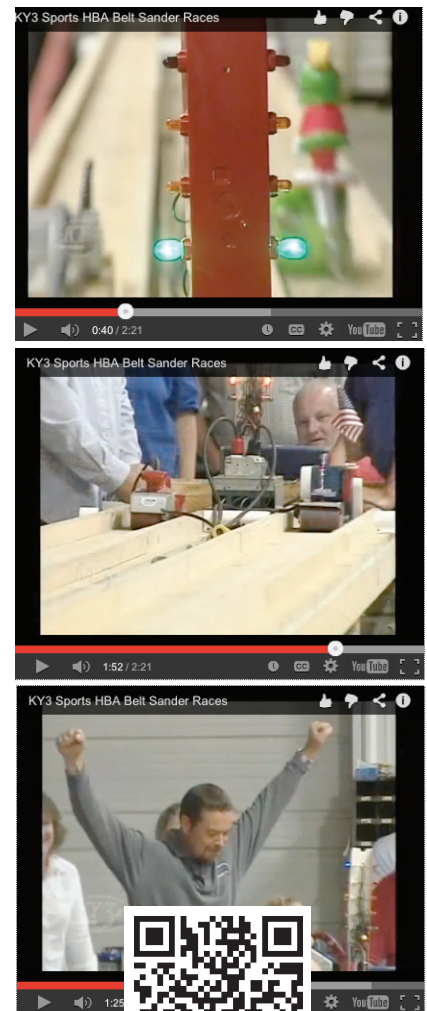
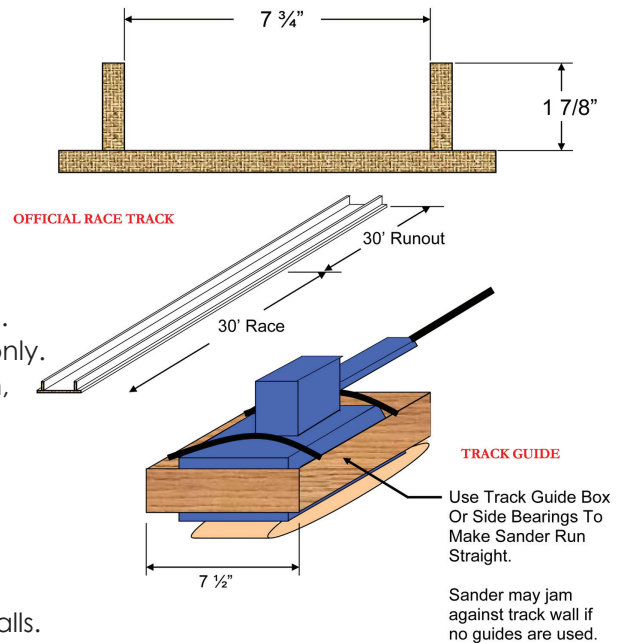
SANDING BELT

- Race entry must run on unaltered, store bought sanding belt.
- Any size or grit of sanding belt acceptable, provided belt fits in track.

RACING

- Race Official's decision is final.
- Race entry owners are responsible for tracking entry belt before each race.
- Race entry owners are responsible for ensuring sander fits into track.
- Race entry owners are responsible for any sander decorations.
- Race entry owners are responsible for all risks or damage to their sander.
- Once sander is placed on track, it can't be touched, adjusted, or interfered with.
- Race Official aligns entries at starting line and plugs in power cord.
- Race Official is responsible for making sure switch is on.
- Race will be replayed if switch was not on, or in Race Official's discretion, and other unfair situation occurred.
- Race Officials collect sanders at the end of track and return them to their owners.
- Sander is disqualified if it stops, jumps track, flips, or does not finish for any reason.
- Racing is conducted on a double elimination basis for each race entry, unless Race Official announces alternative format.
