

## NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids for **THE LINK CROSSING AT SUNSET STREET**, Plan No. 2013PW0063, and **NORTH JORDAN CREEK TRAIL AT CHESTNUT EXPRESSWAY**, 2013PW0065T will be accepted at the City of Springfield, Busch Building, 840 N Boonville, Springfield, MO 65802 until **10:00 A.M. on TUESDAY, MAY 20, 2014**, and then publicly opened and read aloud in the Traffic Engineering / Clean Water Conference Room (106) of the Busch Building. Bids received after 10:00 A.M. MAY 20, 2014, will be returned unopened.

**THE LINK CROSSING AT SUNSET STREET** consists of removal of 450 LF of existing sidewalk, removal and replacement of 60 LF of concrete curb and gutter, 620 SY of 4" thick concrete sidewalk, 50 SY of 6" thick concrete median, and installation of a new high-intensity activated crosswalk (HAWK) traffic signal.

**NORTH JORDAN CREEK TRAIL AT CHESTNUT EXPRESSWAY** consists of 300 SY of 4" thick concrete trail, 30 LF of 30" RCP, 250 SF of retaining wall, 130 LF fencing, 80 LF of concrete drainage swale and installation of 7'x7' junction box.
